

## FM KIDS

*\*Background Screen Required*

### Nursery

This team ministers to children from 6 weeks-1 year. They love on the children through caregiving, nurturing, and developmentally appropriate play.

### Classroom Lead Teacher: Preschool

Our lead Preschool teachers help foster a loving, safe environment for our children ages 1 year- 5 years during services and connect hour. They will help take our preschoolers on a journey of WONDER as we look at three basic truths: (1) God loves me, (2) God made me and (3) Jesus wants to be my Friend forever.

### Classroom Assistant: Preschool [\(First Serve Opportunity\)](#)

Preschool assistants will help the lead teacher create an environment for safety and learning along with assisting with any needs the lead teacher may have.

### Faith Depot FMKids Sanctuary Assistant [\(First Serve Opportunity\)](#)

Each weekend in Faith Depot, we encourage our kids aged Kindergarten through 5th grade to discover who they are in God's Big Story through an exciting and active environment filled with passionate worship, energetic games, great Bible stories that look at three basic truths: (1) I can trust God no matter what, (2) I need to make wise choices, and (3) I should treat others the way I want to be treated. As a sanctuary assistant you will help make sure that this is accomplished by sitting with the children and assisting the lead with whatever is needed to provide safety, fun, and education to the children.

### Faith Depot FMKids Sanctuary Media [\(First Serve Opportunity\)](#)

Our Faith Depot Media tech will be trained in pro-presenter and lighting software. This tech will follow the planning center schedule provided by the lead and will help assist in teaching the children by providing the audio visuals throughout the service.

### Connect Group Lead Teacher: Elementary

Our Elementary Connect Group teachers teach our elementary age children during the 10:00am connect hour. The children are placed in classes by age and the lead teacher fosters discussion and connection, while implementing the Bible story and the same 3 basic truths that are taught during service time. The lesson and activities are created to help them have a better understanding based on their age and gives them life skills that can be applied.

### Connect Group Assistant: Elementary (First Serve Opportunity)

Elementary assistants will help the lead teacher create an environment for safety and learning along with assisting with any needs the lead teacher may have.

### First Impressions (First Serve Opportunity)

Our first impressions team will help with check-in which begins 15 minutes prior to each service time. They will help any new visitors get checked in along with making sure our check-in kiosks are operating. The first impressions team will assist with security and any needs the leads in both areas may have during service time.

## FM STUDENTS

*\*Background Screen Required*

### First Impressions Coordinator

This role is responsible for organizing adults and students for help in greeting, ushering, guest care, and attendance.

### First Impressions Volunteer (First Serve Opportunity)

This team assists the Frontline Coordinator with greeting, ushering, guest care, attendance, and as directed in other necessary responsibilities.

### Media/Tech Coordinator

This role will have the responsibility of organizing production presentation and social media. They are responsible for building and maintaining a media team for weekly worship services.

### Media/Tech Volunteer (First Serve Opportunity)

This role is responsible for running the production presentation in weekly worship services from the direction of the Media/Tech Coordinator.

### Ministry/Stage Presentation Volunteer (First Serve Opportunity)

This role works alongside the Stage Presentation Coordinator to organize and manage the order of service, stage set up, and ministry presentation.

### Café Coordinator

This role is responsible for organizing the café, building a team, setting up and displaying product, and managing food items used in pre or post service environments.

### Café Volunteer (First Serve Opportunity)

This role is responsible for assisting the Café Coordinator with organizing the café, setting up and displaying merchandise, and managing food items used in pre or post service environments.

### Awaken Drama Assistant (First Serve Opportunity)

These roles are to assist the leader of Awaken Drama in choreography, practice planning, and student recruitment.

### Pre/Post Service Volunteer (First Serve Opportunity)

This role assists the Pre/Post Service Coordinator with athletic games before and after service.

### Administrative Volunteer (First Serve Opportunity)

This role works alongside church office staff to assist in communication and care of students and family needs.

### Security Coordinator

This role is responsible for organizing a team of security volunteers and working with the Adult Coordinator and Student Pastor to create a safe environment for students to worship.

### Security Team (First Serve Opportunity)

This team of volunteers work under the direction of the Security Coordinator to create a safe environment for students to worship.

### Group Leaders

This role is expected to lead small group discussions, lead in group competitions, and help manage break out groups within Student Ministry Worship services.

### Connect Group Leaders/Connect Hour Leaders

These individuals are responsible for communicating discipleship and biblical knowledge, building relationships with students, planning meeting times and outings, staying connected to students and providing care to them.

### Social Media/Graphic Volunteer

This team is responsible for developing and creating media for student ministries. They work under the supervision of the Social Media Director.

Awaken Drama Leader

These volunteers organize and recruit for participation in dramatic arts for student ministries. Works alongside the student pastor in scheduling practices and performances.

Free and Redeemed Adult Leader

This is an as-needed position to support the Free and Redeemed Student Leader in planning and organizing for worship, practice, and performances.

Free and Redeemed Student Leader

This role is designed to allow student leadership among peers in the art of worship. Responsibilities include recruiting, planning, and organizing practices and performances. Works alongside the Student Pastor to plan student worship services and any other opportunities.

College Group (First Serve Opportunity)

This team ministers to college students by hosting connect opportunities and events.

**DISCIPLESHIP**Events Team (First Serve Opportunity)

This team is made up of people interested in helping with setup, tear down, and implementation of special events held at FMCOG.

Women's GroupsMen's GroupsServe Days (First Serve Opportunity)

Serve days allow members to serve the FMCOG and community with various outreach projects.

Senior Adult Group (First Serve Opportunity)

This team helps the Senior Adult group when planning and coordinating events, dinners, or trips for those age 55 and up.

**FIRST IMPRESSIONS**Greeting Team (First Serve Opportunity)

This team is responsible for helping guests feel welcome with a friendly “hello” as they enter the building and offering a courteous “goodbye” as they exit.

Usher Team (First Serve Opportunity)

This team is a group of helpful individuals that offer guidance with finding seats, navigating campus, distributing communion, and assisting with needs that may arise during service times.

Parking Lot Team (First Serve Opportunity)

This team is responsible for creating a positive experience for guests from the moment they drive onto the property. This includes friendly greetings, help with parking, and assisting during extreme weather conditions.

**NEXT STEPS**Guest Connect Team (First Serve Opportunity)

This team serves as hosts for greeting first time guests, gathering information, and offering hospitality to individuals discovering their next steps at FMCOG.

Coffee & Connections Team (First Serve Opportunity)

This team helps with our coffee bar setup and act as hosts in a welcoming space for gathering as well as assisting with purchasing any available merchandise.

Baptism Team (First Serve Opportunity)

This team helps people take their next step in their spiritual walk with God through baptism by celebrating with them in that process and assisting with the baptism celebration.

**SECURITY** (First Serve Opportunity)

This team provides safety and security to the church and attendees ranging from kids to adults.

**MISSIONS**Trips (First Serve Opportunity)

FMCOG is connected with many worldwide mission partners. Global trip opportunities to serve in places like Mexico, Ecuador and Tanzania occur frequently.

Local Ministries (First Serve Opportunity)

FMCOG local missions allows serving in ministries that include the FMCOG Food Pantry, Love Life, Palmetto Women's ministries, Hearts Secured Ministries, Hot Dog Cart, and York County Detention Center.



## WORSHIP ARTS

### Choir

Through music, the choir exemplifies, engages and encourages whole-hearted worship to God in the name of Jesus and in the power of the Holy Spirit. The choir sings in the 11:00 service most Sundays. Rehearsals are held on Wednesday evenings from 6:30-8:15 in the sanctuary. Enrollment is open in February and in August.

### Band

The band accompanies the praise team and choir at all regular and special services. Most often, the band and choir rehearse together.

### Dramatic Arts Team (First Serve Opportunity)

This team performs skits, plays, and acts in films. Sometimes drama works in conjunction with the choir's musical presentations particularly during Christmastime and occasionally on Palm Sunday or Easter.

### Mime

This team performs dramatic pantomimes to Christian music. It presents on and off campus throughout the year.

### Dance

This team proffers dance as worship often in collaboration with the choir.

## MEDIA PRODUCTION

*The production team delivers narrative and pre-produced content such as video announcements, short films, and testimonials.*

### Cinematographers (First Serve Opportunity)

Responsible for setting up and operating cameras during production shoots. Works closely with the Director to achieve the desired shot according to their vision.

### Video Editors (First Serve Opportunity)

Responsible for collecting footage and audio from the Cinematographer and Sound Engineers and editing it together in accordance with the director's vision.

### Lighting Engineers (First Serve Opportunity)

Responsible for setting up lighting for each shot. This lighting should be in accordance with the Director's vision and highlight important aspects of the scene.

## PHOTOGRAPHY

*The photography team captures photos during FMCOG services, events, and productions for use in marketing and archiving.*

### Photographer

Captures photos during the FMCOG service, events, and productions. Works with Communications and Media Director to curate photo coverage.
